



## The Firework Safety

Pupils have been discussing safety around fireworks and reminded that children and young people should watch and enjoy fireworks from a safe distance. Please follow these top tips for an enjoyable fireworks party:

- 1. Plan ahead to make your firework display safe and enjoyable
- 2. Keep fireworks in a closed box and use them one at a time
- 3. Read and follow the instructions on each firework
- 4. Light the firework at arm's length with a taper and stand well back
- 5. Keep naked flames, including cigarettes, away from fireworks
- 6. Never return to a firework once it has been lit
- 7. Don't put fireworks in pockets and never throw them
- 8. Direct any rocket fireworks well away from spectators




