
Woodcroft International Day on Monday 21st October

Nasal Flu Vaccinations For Woodcroft Pupils

The annual nasal flu vaccination date for Woodcroft is **Friday 8th November**. This is for every primary school aged child from Reception to Year 6. (Nursery aged children will receive this via their GP service)

The children's flu vaccine is a safe and effective nasal spray. (Note: The spray contains gelatine. A vegan version is available via injection and can be requested)

Children catch and spread the flu easily. Flu can be very unpleasant for children and can sometimes cause serious problems, such as pneumonia. Vaccinating children also helps protect others who are at higher risk of getting seriously ill from flu, such as babies and older people.



Daily Reading At Home is Essential The Benefits of Reading Aloud Together at Home

We understand the challenges! We are all busy and finding the time to fit everything into our family schedule is difficult, to say the least. However, we think it is so important to find the time for 15 minutes of reading a day. This is necessary to prepare your child for the future - whatever their age (Nursery to Year 6)! That's because reading aloud improves accuracy and fluency - something independent silent reading cannot do.



15 minutes a day makes all the difference, with either the

adult or the child reading the book; or even better, taking turns! 15 minutes daily reading = 5,475 minutes (or 91 hours) of practice every year!!!

Why read aloud? Research shows that reading aloud with your child is <u>the</u> number one thing you can do to help prepare them for future success. In fact at Woodcroft we could say, *read aloud together for success* - now where have we heard that before?

Barnet Household Fund Voucher Scheme Autumn shopping vouchers worth £42.30 to spend at supermarkets



Children eligible for pupil premium and benefit related free school meals will receive the Autumn voucher from the Barnet's Household Fund Voucher Scheme today.

Woodcroft has provided every eligible child with a **£42.30** shopping voucher to support families. This scheme allows Woodcroft to provide vouchers to families electronically, directly to your phone via email to spend on food at a range of shops including Sainsbury's, Tesco, Aldi, Asda, etc.

We will then arrange for you to provide your evidence so that you can begin to receive one of our free food or voucher offers.

***Please note**: eligibility for 'benefit related' Free School Meals is different from the Universal Infant Free School Meals given to every KS1 and Reception pupils and London Mayors Fund meals provided free to pupils in KS2. You must be in receipt of certain benefits to claim the vouchers.

Nursery admissions from age 3 years old

Woodcroft Nursery accepts applications for children to start from the age of 3 years old.

We enrol children at the start of each term when they are three:

- For a **September** start date a child must turn 3 before 31st August.
- For a **January** start date a child must turn 3 between 1st September and 31st December.
- For an April start date a child must turn 3 before March 31st

For children that have already had their 3rd or 4th birthday please contact the school office to discuss whether we have any vacancies.

Immediate Start in Autumn Term 2024 – born between 1st September 2020 to 31st August 2021. January 2025 start – born between 1st September 2021 to 31st December 2021 April 2025 start – born between 1st January 2022 and 31st March 2022

Childcare parents of three and four year olds that are registered with Woodcroft's Nursery can also apply for the new **30 hours free childcare** offer. Children in Nursery, Reception Year 1 and Year 2 do not need to bring in snacks. Fresh fruit is provided free to every child every day!

KS2 - Years 3 to 6

If you wish to send your child with a snack please make sure it is wrapped or boxed.

- Small sandwich or crackers



Important Note: We do not allow any chocolate or nut products in school. This is because some children have severe allergies. Please do not send in chocolate cakes or biscuits for snacks that are then stored in the classrooms.
