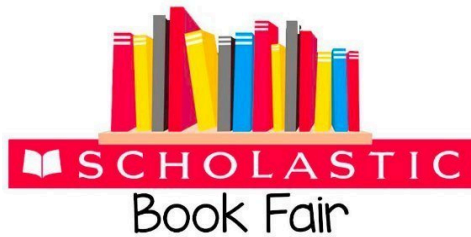

EYFS Oral Health Workshop

On Wednesday 13th November, we had a lovely NHS promoter attend our early years setting at Woodcroft. She delivered an informative parent workshop about children's oral hygiene and provided oral health tools to help fully implement the Supervised Toothbrushing Programme in our setting.

Promoting good Oral Health is in our EYFS Framework!

A survey carried out by Public Health England of children in 2020 found that nearly a quarter of 5 year olds children have tooth decay!

Pupils were given their own toothbrush, taught about the importance of brushing and how to brush properly. We then all joined in with our very FIRST supervised toothbrushing session in Nursery!

In what has been a very busy week, pupils in KS2 have been battling it out in the first TTRS tournament of the year. Here is a summary of the results.
