"The chicks claws felt quite sharp" (Maria)



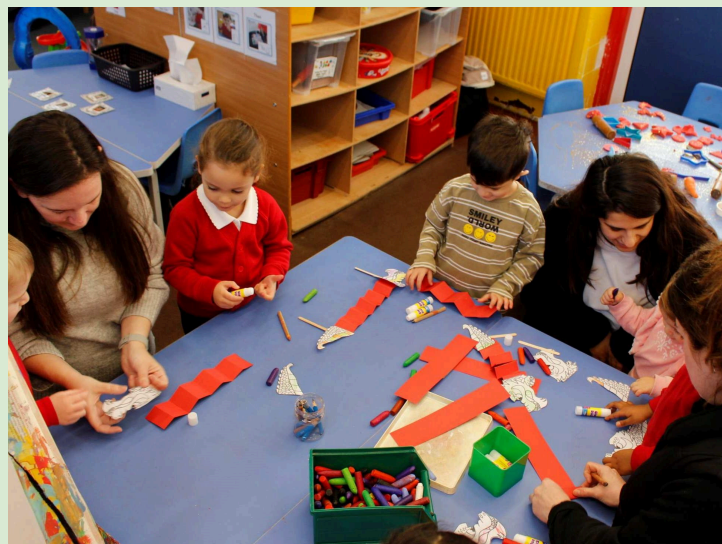
Cheerleaders' Cake Sale THANK YOU

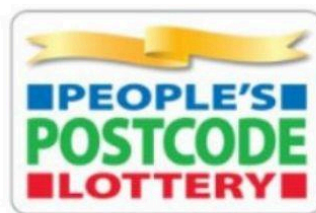
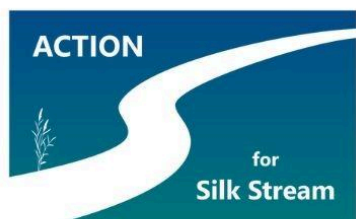
