EYFS Butterfly Project Week 4: Our Butterflies Emerge and Fly Free! 🦋



What an exciting week! Our **Painted Lady butterflies** emerged from their chrysalides. We watched in awe as they stretched and dried their wings. Pupils fed them with nectar (sugar water) and fruit slices. We talked about the importance of pollinators and how butterflies play a crucial role in our environment. Our classrooms were full of excitement as we prepared to gently release our butterflies into their natural habitat, helping them begin the next chapter of their lifecycle. After a few days of observation and care, we released our beautiful butterflies in our very own Butterfly Garden. Pupils reflected on the full life cycle and shared what they learned. It was a beautiful moment watching them fly free.

Y4 Pupils Succeed in The Multiplication Tables Check

Well done to all of our Year 4 pupils for another outstanding year of results in the National Multiplications Timestables Check (the MTC). Overall we achieved a fantastic average of 20 and achieved the expected standard.



London Rocks is a capital-wide time tables competition linked to London Maths Week. Woodcroft pupils have been taking part over the past three days. We have achieved our **BEST EVER results!** These notably include:

- ★ Woodcroft achieved overall 2nd Place in London out of 355 competing schools!
- ★ 6C were the #1 top class in London (5R were 7th) out of 2635 classes taking part!
- ★ Maxim (Y4) & George (Y6) were both in the top 50 students out of 26,095!

It was a nailbiting finish, especially for 6C, who were neck and neck right up to the last minute. Also, with less than 1 hour remaining we also caught, and overtook, the school previously in second place to claim silver for ourselves! 

Events

Classes will rotate around a series of activity-bases scoring points for their team. Parents can follow their child around the circuit. We ask that families stand back to allow school staff to organise their pupils without distraction.

Sprint Finals

After the events, we will have a **Sprint Final**. The fastest pupil from each team will have a class final. The winner from each class will compete in a race-off in a key stage final.

Dismissal of KS1

After the KS1 and Early Years sports day, parents and carers will take their children directly home from the sports centre. Class teachers will dismiss pupils at the end of the event.

Suitable sun hats in school and for sports day

As the weather improves, we recommend that children wear hats at break times as part of their sun-safe behaviour. However, can we remind parents that caps should be appropriate for school. That means they should be plain and without bold logos. We do not allow graffiti-style caps or the latest 'Snapback' or sports designs. These are expensive fashion items and have caused problems in the past. Hats should ideally follow our school uniform code and be red, grey, black, blue or white.

Woodcroft Is a WATER ONLY School



By choosing water, this means children are not drinking sugary drinks which contribute to many preventable health conditions like obesity, tooth decay and type 2 diabetes.

Please only fill your child's bottle with water - juice is not allowed.

Personal 'PLASTIC' Refillable Water Bottles

As we encourage the regular drinking of water throughout the day it is important to have a sensible, reusable plastic bottle.



- 1. Every child should have a named reusable water bottle.
- Bottles should be brought to school filled with fresh water every day. Personal water bottles are taken home every day to be washed.
- 3. We do not allow single use disposable bottles in school.
- 4. We do not recommend metal bottles as they become dented, unstable and make a noise when knocked over in class. Please also avoid oversized bottles (e.g. the latest Stanley versions) as they take up too much table space!

Refillable Plastic Water Bottles: Always remember your refillable water bottle. We do not want to see disposable single use bottles in school. Not only are these bad for the environment, they are also distracting in class. You would be surprised at the noise they make in a quiet classroom when children are concentrating in their learning. We also discourage metal bottles and those that are oversized. Note: younger children in Y2 and below do NOT need any equipment from home

Nursery admissions open for September 2025

30 Hours provision is available at Woodcroft Nursery for children that are aged 3 or 4 years old Now is the time to reserve your Nursery place. Children start Nursery when they are 3 years old

- For a September start date a child must turn 3 on or before 31st August.
- For a January start date a child must turn 3 between 1st September and 31st December.
- For an April start date a child must turn 3 on or before the 31st March

Children that are already aged 3 to 4 years old can be admitted at any time subject to places being available. Younger children should be placed on our waiting list as early as possible to guarantee a place.
