Woodcroft pupils and staff all came together to pay their respects, and wear our poppies, for a 2 minute silence on Tuesday 11th November at 11.00am.



## **Year 1 Music Festival**




Well done to our Year 1 pupils for their fantastic performance in this week's Barnet Infant Music Festival hosted at Woodcroft.

## Be Punctual - Be On Time For Success



It is so important for children to be in school and at their desks ready for the start of the first lesson. **Doors open at 8.30am** and registration is 8.45am. If children arrive late:

- They miss vital explanations at the start of lessons
- Disturb the whole class' learning
- Take office staff away from their administrative duties

Establishing good habits of punctuality is a way of helping your child to become successful. Our school motto is 'together towards success' so we will be reminding everyone to 'BE ON TIME FOR SUCCESS'.

## **Safe Dismissal Arrangements**

At Woodcroft we need to coordinate the safe dismissal of over 400 children every day. To ensure this is carried out correctly we follow the same principles across the school.

Can we remind parents again that if you need to make changes to regular arrangements they need to inform the school office as early in the day as possible. Calling the office at 3.00pm does not give school enough time to communicate changes with classteachers. Please call before 2.00pm.

## **Woodcroft is a Smartphone Free School**

We believe that smartphones can do significant harm to primary age children. As a result, the Governing Body of Woodcroft has decided to make our school smart phone free. This is also a Barnet-wide policy and means pupils are not allowed to bring a smartphone to school.



All smartphones brought to school by pupils will be confiscated and only returned to an adult.

If older children *absolutely* need a phone when travelling independently to and from school then they will be allowed to bring a traditional feature phone that allows calls and texts only. ## Free Child Car Seat Checks

Barnet Council is offering free child car seat safety checks to ensure children are travelling safely. A trained expert from Good Egg Safety will be available to **inspect seats**, **fix errors and provide advice**, no booking required.

A check can be made on your child car seat even if your child isn't with you — but if they are, we can also check they are seated correctly and safely.

Last year, **92% of seats checked in Barnet had errors**, many serious enough to endanger children in the event of a collision. Unfortunately, errors on seats are very easily made, but the great news is that they tend to be easy to fix.
