Mission statement

We are determined to ensure that our pupils are given every chance to realize their full potential. Year 7 Catch Up premium funding enhances our curriculum offer for those eligible students.

Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2019-2020

The funding allocation for 2019-2020 was **£10,875**. Our focus has been to allocate resources to support the development of literacy and numeracy skills, which in turn affects all areas of their curriculum.

This year, the money was spent on:

- Continued employment of a Learning Guide with specific roles to provide catch up and targeted intervention work with our year 7 pupils (part funded hours) (£5,619)
- Speech and Language input (Talking House) (£1,000)
- Resources to support Year 7 curriculum at Woodhouse/Boston spa (contribution £1,760)
- Year 7 entry/exit experiences linked to new curriculum (£458)
- Education City licence contribution (£300)
- Lexia reading package contribution (£300)
- Contribution towards ICT equipment (£1,438)

Year 7 Catch –up premium funding had enhanced attainment of Year 7 pupils across one of our target 7 areas (Reading) and the Year 7 cohort have achieved as well as other cohorts in the other five target areas.
