Scope Activities for All

Scope “Activities for All” is a universal plus service which aims to encourage and support access to universal activity settings (dance, drama, scouts, sports, arts and crafts and anything else) to meet the needs of children with SEND. They will work with any universal service that are offering leisure activities giving advice and support using their Scope Inclusive Activity Award (SIAA) ensuring access to universal activities is a real possibility. Alongside the SIAA Scope can also offer additional support through their “sessional workers” who will act as a bridge between home and the setting. They will attend with your child to upskill the group and backfill their staffing. The support is on a short-term basis and compliments the team at Activities for All who will work with the setting to develop the practice of the group so the young person can continue after the support is withdrawn, taking ownership of providing support to all children in their setting. Process to apply for a sessional worker:-

- Parent/carer to find an activity (*try, internet local offer, word of mouth, Facebook pages, looking at community noticeboards local library*)
- Email leedsplaypartners@scope.org.uk for a referral form.
- A sessional worker is identified.
- After 3-4 sessions we will assess the activity and work towards a withdrawal plan supporting the group with our Inclusive activity Award.
