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


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Welcome to the Spring 2024 Through The Maze newsletter


Let's look at... Staying safe – Ask for Angela



Ask for Angela is a way for people to get help if they feel unsafe when they are out.

Lots of pubs and clubs in Leeds are part of the scheme. And some restaurants and other venues are in the scheme.





If someone is making you feel unsafe ask the staff if you can speak to Angela.


This tells the staff you need help.

The staff will take you to a safe space or help you to get home.

You might feel unsafe because someone is threatening you.

You might feel unsafe because someone is getting too close to you.





You might feel unsafe because someone is asking you to do things that make you uncomfortable.

Whatever it is that makes you feel unsafe you can **ask for Angela**.





Ask for Angela is similar to the Safe Places scheme.







A friendship group for adults with learning disabilities aged 18+ to meet new friends and do fun activities, either at the office or out in the community.

All activities are planned and organized by our members.




NVQ Level 2 Food Hygiene Course




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Victor's notes from a Visioning Group session



William with a sheet of members' ideas and comments



Let's look at... giving people more control over the services and groups they are in

Through The Maze visited the Visioning Group at Pyramid.

We wanted to find out what they do to help all Pyramid's members have more control.

Visioning Group member Victor said

The Visioning Group is to make sure Pyramid is led by its members. We want to create change in society through our art. So, it is important to break down barriers to our members being in control.

The Visioning Group spent time working out what is important for this to happen.

They made sure all Pyramid members had the chance to have a say.

Visioning Group member William said

We started planning by using single words that describe what Pyramid does. Then we drew ideas about what this means for people.

We took complicated ideas and made them simple. This was so we could check with the other Pyramid members what was missing.



Members made figures called Pyramites. These were another way for members to show what they thought Pyramid should be doing.

Our Vision

An artist with autism working the group made easy read symbols using the Pyramites. These are used in the plan.

After making the plan the Visioning Group wanted to find ways to make the ideas in the plan become real.

We want our member artists to make the choice of what projects they do.

The Arts Council have funded us to test ways of giving our groups control over what themes they do their art about.

Our paid group leaders will propose ideas to the group for how the art could be done.

Group members will choose the proposal they want and which group leaders to work with.

We have funding so that people with a learning disability can be part of the group leader teams.

We are also working on members having more chances to do individual work.

We run fun groups and courses. These are designed to help the group members learn new things, as well as have fun and stay connected.


