



ASA Job Description

Job Title: Junior Ranger Sustrans Volunteer Program

Description of Activity:

Sustrans Volunteer can offer a half day (2.5 hours) practical conservation session.

This would give the young people an opportunity to volunteer as “Junior Rangers” for Sustrans Volunteer Program and gain experience for their Active Students Award.

The school is ideally placed for access onto National Cycle Network (NCN) track number 155 (which continues right through to Ashington, eventually joining NCN1).

The track we would focus on starts from Corporation Yard and heads up Whorral Bank towards, and south of Pegswood.

The tasks would involve to up keeping this track section and would include litter picking and leaf mulch removal.

Sustrans would be able to provide a leader for the day of activities (Volunteer Coordinator) along with Sustrans Volunteer support and tools and PPE (gloves and high visibility jackets).

After the first led session (half day), we would encourage the group to adopt the section of track and continue to do a number of workdays which would contribute to their hours.
