Available support	How do I contact them?
Form Tutor	Either see them before or after registration or send them an email asking for a chat or explaining your concern.
Pastoral Coordinator (Years 9-11)	Your Pastoral Coordinators are available to help throughout the day. They are based in the year office and can also be contacted via email. You will also find them on duty at break and lunch in your year group areas.
Academic Mentors (Year 12 and 13)	Our academic mentors, Mrs Brown, Mrs Nottinger and Mrs Schreier are available throughout the day. Mrs Brown and Mrs Nottinger are based in the sixth form centre, whilst Mrs Schreier can be found in her office at the back of the LRC.
Year Leaders (Years 9-13)	Every year group has a year leader. Our Year Leaders are also teachers, so can be found either in their classrooms or in their offices.
Student Support Area	The Student Support Area is available to support students with concerns that you may have. Mrs Rayne is the receptionist and the area is managed by Mrs Gilholm.
Careers Advice	Mrs Schreier is our Careers specialist who is available to work with students across the school. Please email Mrs Schreier or find her in her office at the back of the LRC.
Chaplains	We have two Chaplains who work in school. Nick Rowark is the Lower School Chaplain who works with students from year 9 to 11, whilst Beth Rookwood works with years 12 and 13. Both have a base in school and can be contacted via email.
Counselling Service	We are very fortunate to have a team of counsellors who are based in school. If you would like counselling please email or speak with any of the staff above to be referred. Alternatively, you can refer yourself by emailing kevi.counselling@the3rivers.net
