

Keelman's Way School Home-School Agreement

The School will:

- Value and care for each child as a unique individual.
- Aim to provide the best possible education for every child, meeting his or her individual special needs.
- Be open and welcoming, creating a secure and friendly atmosphere for children and parents/carers.
- Inform parents/carers about school activities and what their child will be taught each term. This will be displayed on the School Website by means of newsletters, curriculum maps, class news pages and a calendar of important dates.
- Give parents and carers information about their child's progress.
- Provide a home/school diary to be used for daily written communication between teachers and parent/carers.
- Provide some homework as appropriate.

Parents/carers will:

- See that their child attends school regular and inform the school when their child is absent.
- Ensure their child is ready in time for their transport, or brought to school by 9am.
- Ensure their child wears the correct uniform for school and is well equipped for the school day.
- Attend Annual Reviews and Open days to discuss their child's progress.
- Share with school (in confidence if necessary) major events at home that may affect their child's emotions or well-being.
- Attend any meeting with professionals such as Doctors, SALT, OT, Physiotherapy, and to keep school involved to ensure we work together for the child's benefit.
- Use the home-school diary regularly to inform school of what the child has been doing at home and of any changes to routine, such as appointments.
- Raise any concerns directly with the school through the accepted policy and not via social media

Together we will:

- Enable every child to develop to their full potential.
- Encourage pupils to believe in themselves, raise their self-esteem and take pride in their environment.
- Help our children develop a sense of responsibility and respect for others.
- Share any concerns or problems affecting the child.
- Ensure close liaison between home and school on all medical issues relating to the child.
