You will be aware that, as a part of your child's educational experience at Keelman's Way School, we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education; Giving our young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthy, safe, productive and fulfilled lives, appropriate to them, both now and in the future.
