Subject	Focus	Key Knowledge and Skills
English	Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can listen to and discuss a wide range of fiction, poetry, non-fiction and fables. I can read age-appropriate books with confidence and fluency. I can predict what might happen from details stated and implied. I can summarise main ideas and identify key details.
	Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and capital letters. I can use more ambitious word choices in my writing and begin to use paragraphs. I can use a range of adverbs and subordinating conjunctions. I can include dialogue in my writing by using inverted commas.
	Grammar & Spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use a wider range of conjunctions and punctuation such as inverted commas. I can use Spelling Shed to practise our weekly spelling pattern.
Maths	Number and Place Value	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can compare and order numbers up to 1000. I can recognise the place value of each digit in a three digit number.
	Addition and Subtraction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can add and subtract numbers up to three digits, using formal written methods such as the column method. I can estimate the answer to a calculation and use the inverse operation to check my answer.
	Multiplication and Division	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division, using mental and progressing to formal written methods. I can recall the 3, 4 and 8 times table and know the division facts.

	Measures (Money)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can add and subtract amounts of money to give change using both £ and p in practical contexts.
	Geometry (Angles)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can identify right angles and make turns accordingly.
Science	Forces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can explain similarities and differences and talk about changes. I can work systematically and make changes to design a game using magnets.
	Humans including Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can classify and present data linked to Humans and Animals. I can identify that animals including humans need the right type and amount of nutrition.
