Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can count to and across 100, forwards and backwards. I can count, read and write numbers to 100 and count in multiples of twos, fives and tens. I can use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20 add and subtract numbers to 20, including zero. I can solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction. I can solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division. I can describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns. I can solve problems involving time. I can read and draw the clock hands to show o'clock and half past.
