Focus	Key Knowledge and Skills
Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can listen to simple stories and understand what is happening. • I can understand simple questions about 'who', 'what' and 'where'. • I can follow instructions with three key words. • I enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens. • I will start to say how I am feeling using words as well as actions.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can run confidently. • I can kick a ball. • I can jump with both feet off the ground at the same time. • I can use large-muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks • I can use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors. • I can use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.
Personal, Social, Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I will begin to show 'effortful control'. For example, waiting for a turn and resisting the strong impulse to grab what I want or push my way to the front. • I am beginning to manage my emotions. • I am beginning to talk about my emotions e.g. 'sad', 'happy' or 'upset'. • I will learn to use the toilet independently or with help
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I enjoy sharing books with adults. • I can repeat words and phrases from familiar stories. • I can ask questions about a book. • I can notice some print, such as the first letter of my name, a bus or door number or a familiar logo. • I enjoy drawing freely. • I can add some marks to my drawings, which I give meaning to. For example: 'That's my mummy.' • I can make marks to represent my name.

Maths

- I can react to changes of amount in a group of up to 3 items.
- I can count in everyday contexts, sometimes skipping numbers.
- I can join in with finger rhymes with numbers.
- I can notice patterns, for example, spots and stripes and arrange things in patterns.
- I can complete inset puzzles.
- I will have fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').
- I can sort/match - sort groups of objects according to different criteria
- I can make comparisons relating to size.
- I can talk about 'My day'
