Subject	Focus	Key Knowledge and Skills
English	Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use phonic knowledge to read new words. I can read aloud books that are consistent with the sounds I know. I enjoy listening to a range of stories linked to emotions.
	Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can spell words containing one syllable using the sounds I know. I can write a simple sentence as dictated by the teacher.
	Grammar & Spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use a capital letter at the start of a sentence and when using 'I'. I can leave spaces between words.
Maths	Number and Place Value	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can subitise to 10. I can count within 100 in different ways. I can explain that items can be compared using length, height, weight/mass, volume/capacity. I can count and compare a set of objects.
	Comparison of Quantities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use greater than, less than and equal to symbols. I can use a part-whole model.
	2D and 3D Shapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use ordinal numbers. I can partition numbers. I can say one more and one less than a given number. I can compose pattern block images. I can explore, discuss and identify different shapes and identify their cut outs.
Science	Senses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can identify basic parts of the human body.

	Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. I can name a range of materials. I can describe the simple properties of everyday materials.
