FEARLESS

Fearless is a new site, independent from the police, where you can access non judgemental advice on crime and criminality. The site also allows the user to provide information on crime—100% anonymously!

The sites aimed at 11—16 year olds and provides a useful A to Z guide on crime types allowing you to access a range of information on specific incidents.

To raise the profile of Fearless.org amongst professionals working with young people we are offering free training covering the following themes:

- Review and recap of Crimestoppers
- Introduction to our youth brand and activity
- Equip you with all of our available tools & resources

The training is suitable for anyone working with young people. In the past we have trained Safer Schools Officers, sports coaches, school nurses, teachers, Safer Neighbourhood Teams, youth workers and YOT workers.

How many?

To get the best from a training session we would recommend the training for groups of between 8-30 people.

How long?

The sessions lasts between 1.5 to 2.5 hours depending on the number of people being trained.
