Student Reports and Parents’ Evenings 2019-20

Report Content

This academic year there will be 3 reporting cycles. Students will be assessed each term and a report of their progress will be issued towards the end of that term.

Students in Years 7-10 will be allocated one End of Year Target grade. Year 11 students will retain their target from Year 10. Students will be expected to achieve their target grade by the end of the academic year. Each QA cycle, teachers will provide a Current Attainment grade (based on teacher assessments), a Prediction grade (the grade the teacher believes the child is capable of reaching by the end of the year) and an Attitude to Learning grade.

Reporting Cycles (QA Data Collections)

Written Reports (detailed reports including teacher comments) will be issued on Parents’ Evenings. Progress Reports (one page summary reports) will continue to be published online. Parents will be notified when a report is available. Reports can be accessed online by visiting the college website, Parents/Carers section and using the GO 4 Schools login page provided.
