Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to share with you how Denton Community College intends to issue GCSE results to your child on Results day (Thursday 20th August 2020). The procedures for your child to receive their GCSE Grades on the 20th August 2020 will differ from previous years as a result of the unprecedented conditions created by the Coronavirus pandemic. However, as a college we believe that it is important that students have the opportunity to receive their GCSE results in person, at college, on the day they are released.

In order to do this we are putting in place clear guidance so that we are able to maintain a safe and COVID-Secure environment for both staff and students. We are proposing to give the students their GCSE results in the following manner.

Students will be given a timeslot to attend college to receive their results, the time they are allocated will be linked to their form tutor group. Students must not arrive before their allotted time, students must arrive at the time allotted to them.

- On arrival at college students must wait outside the main entrance of the college and maintain social distance in line with government guidance.
- Students will be invited into college to collect their results.
- Students will be expected to sanitise their hands on arrival and sign for their results.
- Guidance will be available from the local colleges on the day
