On **Friday 15**<sup>th</sup> **January 2021**, the Department for Education (DfE) announced the opening of the consultation regarding their proposals for replacing the GCSE examination series schedules for the summer of 2021. In the DfE press release, which can be found <u>here</u>, it is proposed that teachers are to determine grades using a range of evidence that reflects students' hard work and ability.

The DfE and Ofqual (the exams regulator) have recognise the impact the disruption to education has had over the last year and are seeking views on how to award grades in a way that accurately reflects students' performance. Details regarding their proposals can be found in the document 'Consultation on how GCSE, AS and A level grades should be awarded in summer 2021' a copy of which can be found here.
