**Dear Parents & Carers** 

I hope this letter finds you and your loved ones safe and well at this time.

I am writing to share with you how Denton Community College intends to issue GCSE results to your child on Results Day (Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022). The arrangement we adopt to issue results allows not only our students to celebrate their success with their peers but also allows support, guidance and interventions to be provided if required.

All students will be given an allocated timeslot which is linked to their tutor group. Students must not arrive before their allotted time and must only arrive at the time assigned to them. These time slots are as follows:

Students who are unable to attend can send a representative to collect results on their behalf. This representative must have signed permission from the student (Not the parent/carer) and a form of identification. This permission must be in the format of a letter signed by the student and naming the individual picking up their results. Please note that emails, text or social media messages, as well as telephone messages on the day do not constitute relevant permission and the students' results will not be handed over to the representative. For the issuing of results the term representative means any person who is not the student, this includes parents & carers. Any uncollected results will be sent out by first class post at 12.30pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August.
