Student Progress, Reports and Parents' Evenings 2022-23

Following a review of school software systems, we have decided to phase out the online GO 4 Schools software we previously used for recording student progress and revert to our core SIMS system for this. The system is not currently accessible remotely. We will therefore provide regular updates to Parents/Carers on student progress in hard copy report format and during parents' evenings.

Types of progress data recorded

Each student has one target, a national average grade the government believes a student should reach by the end of their key stage.

Students in Years 7, 8 and 9 have a KS3 target for the end of Year 9. Students in Years 10 and 11 have a KS4 target for the end of Year 11.

Targets exist for each subject, calculated from a student's KS2 prior attainment from their primary school. Where there is no prior attainment score, students are allocated low targets until such time as we are able to either baseline test them (Years 8 and 9), or obtain official KS2 prior attainment from the government (Years 7, 10 and 11) and review their targets.

Each term, teachers record the following information for their students*:

Current attainment grades 1-9 or vocational grades i.e. BTEC	This is a working at grade
Current attainment sub level	Applicable to students below grade 1
I (Introducing), D (Developing), F (Functional) where F is higher	
Above, Below, In Line	An indication of progress to target for KS3
Attitude to Learning grade 1-4	Attendance/commitment to learning
Home Learning grade 1-4	Level of engagement with homework

^{*}For students joining the college during a data collection period partial or no data will be available until the following term.
