Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the process that happens following the publication of the Ofsted inadequate report in March, Ofsted will be conducting a monitoring visit on Tuesday 11th and Wednesday 12th July 2023. You will be aware of the changes we have already made to the school and of the changes we have planned for September, and Ofsted are seeking your views.

"We would like to invite all registered parents of registered pupils at the school to inform Ofsted of their views about the school via Ofsted's online survey site, Ofsted Parent View. Ofsted is inspecting your child's school and we would like to know what you think about the school. Your views about the school are important to us.

If you are a registered parent or carer of a pupil at the school (including pupils on sick leave or who are temporarily excluded), you can tell us your views about the school by completing Ofsted's online survey, Ofsted Parent View, at: www.parentview.ofsted.gov.uk.

Ofsted Parent View asks for your opinion on some aspects of your child's school, including the progress made by your child, the quality of teaching, how the school deals with bullying and poor behaviour. It also provides a free-text box for you to make additional comments, if you wish. The inspectors will use the online survey responses when inspecting your child's school.

To register your views, you will need to provide your email address, which will be held securely. It will not be used for any purpose other than providing access to the online survey. Neither schools nor Ofsted will have access to any email addresses.

Please complete the online survey as soon as possible, preferably by 11am on the first day of the inspection, as this will give the inspection team more time to consider your views. However, we will consider all online responses that are completed during the inspection, although the free-text box facility will not be available after noon on the final on-site day of the inspection."

Thank you for taking the time to talk to them about the school and the changes we are making.
