



PRIMARY PUPILS PROTOCOL FOR RETURNING TO SCHOOL DURING COVID-19

Your teachers look forward to welcoming you back to school. However, they will be welcoming you back to a school that needs to be organised differently to make sure we can enjoy learning again, but SAFELY. We need you to follow the rules below to keep us all safe:

MUST DO:



Your safety is our priority, therefore if you have any underlying medical **conditions** that could place you at an increased risk by being in school, we are encouraging your parents to keep you home until school is safe.

In school and whilst outside on our playgrounds or field (and when you are outside with your families at home), you will need to follow the **Government guidance for social distancing**. Please do not meet up with other friends or family without staying 2m apart.



Stay by your parents side when waiting to come in to school. You are not allowed to run around and mix with others on your way in. Wait in the car until the doors open or plan your walk to arrive at the right time for your door to open.



If your uniform still fits, please wear it. If it's now too small, please wear clothes that are comfortable and that you can manage to put on independently. You will need to bring spare clothes in case of any accidents. Please don't bring lace-up shoes, unless you can tie them independently.

If you feel unwell, it is important you tell your parent and stay at home.



You must **wash your hands** as soon as you enter school and regularly throughout the day, remembering to sing 'Happy Birthday' twice. You will need to wash your hands before going home.



Travel safely. Follow **Government guidelines** and where possible, walk to school.

It important you don't car share with anyone who does not live in your home. If you come to school by bus, remember to wear a mask.



Do not share toys and equipment. We need you to keep the toys and equipment, which you are using, to yourself and not share with your friends. We have chosen things you will like and that you can play safely with.



Stay 2m apart at all times, in class and around school. You must not hug or touch other children and teachers, even how hard you might find this!



Remember to bring your own labelled water bottle and **a labelled packed lunch, unless you have a school dinner.**

Have food in your lunch bag that you can open and manage by yourself.

You **MUST** listen and follow instructions carefully. We have some new rules in our **school updated behaviour policy** to help keep everyone safe.

At SSPP we will all:

Stay safe - keep our own personal space & follow rules to stay safe

Allow others to be safe- Never share germs or cause others to worry

Show respect- be kind, care for and look after one another, including the staff



Put sun-cream on before you come to school.

If you must bring some with you it must be named, you cannot share it and you will need to put it on yourself.

If you bring your own hand-gel or tissues, keep these to yourself also

Remember to keep your hair tied back, nails short, hands clean, and bring only a jacket and a named water bottle (no jewellery, no pencil case, no PE kit or bag please).
