- It's true that honeybees have a special dance they perform once they have discovered a source of nectar. It consists of a circle dance and a tail wagging dance, that accurately tell other bees the angle from the sun and the distance to the nectar – clever stuff!
- Talk about why bees collect nectar and what they make from it. Talk about their hives and that there are drones, worker bees and a Queen Bee in each colony. Ask the children if they know why bees have a stinger. Have any of the children ever been stung by a bee? How did it feel?
