SWIM ENGLAND TEACHER OF SCHOOL SWIMMING COURSE 2021/2022



Why?

The Swim England Support Teacher of School Swimming Course (previously titled Fundamentals of School Swimming) MUST be completed before undertaking this course. This certificated course completes the Swim England National Curriculum Training Programme and is recognised by the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF) and by the Professional Development Board for Physical Education.

What?

This course develops learners' understanding of progressive aquatic skills (including water safety); each of the 4 strokes as well as looking at progressive practice and stroke analysis. Delegates have the opportunity to work with pupils to deliver short lessons based on skills learnt during the day. Led by a Swim England Licensed Tutor, this course consists of 8 hours' contact time, 2 hours' pre-course reading and includes theory and practical.

Who can attend?

Teachers, TA's, LSA's, DBS checked school staff, Trainee Primary School Teachers.

Pre requisites:

Delegates <u>MUST</u> have completed the Swim England Support Teacher of School Swimming before undertaking this course.
