

SECONDARY TEACHER OF SCHOOL SWIMMING

The BSSP Secondary Teacher of School Swimming Course is a minimum requirement for all staff who accompany pupils to swimming lessons in Buckinghamshire.

Led by a Swim England Licensed Tutor, this course consists of 8 hours contact time and includes theory and practical. The course will usually be delivered over one day and there will be some additional pre-course reading required. It provides lots of fun ideas for teaching non swimmers through to more advanced swimmers; examples of how to deliver swimming through aquatics; the opportunity to explore and use a wide range of resources.

Course content:

-  Roles and responsibilities; Health and safety; safeguarding and protecting children; organisation of the learning environment,
-  Importance of physical literacy in school swimming; developing key underpinning skills and essential components of the four strokes,
-  Planning, preparing and delivery of aquatic sessions; core aquatic skills; stroke faults and progressive practices,
-  Key considerations for Key Stage 3 & 4 Skills in the Water; taster activities for Water Polo, Synchronised Swimming, Water Safety and Self-Rescue.
