

SUPPORTING PUPILS WITH SEND DURING SCHOOL SWIMMING

We are pleased to be able to offer this specially adapted Swim England Support Teacher of School Swimming Course which is aimed at staff in Special Schools or staff working in mainstream schools with pupils who have sensory and physical needs. This is a minimum requirement for all staff who accompany pupils to swimming lessons in both Buckinghamshire.

This Swim England certificated course comprises the National Curriculum Training Programme and is recognised by the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF) and by the Professional Development Board for Physical Education.

Course content:

-  Develop an awareness and greater understanding of SEND and Inclusion within National Curriculum Physical Education,
-  Gain an understanding of the barriers to swimming and Identify methods/strategies/techniques to overcome these for swimmers with SEND/ Inclusion needs,
-  Identify good practice with regards to health and safety,
-  Understand roles and responsibilities,
-  Have an understanding of the importance of adapting your lessons to meet the individual needs of these swimmers,
-  Identify the methods of communication and resources to support swimmers with SEND/Inclusion needs,
-  How to develop water confidence using core aquatic skills?
-  How to introduce the swimming strokes?
