With the colder weather now upon us please ensure your child brings a warm winter coat. As PE is held outside, weather permitting, please make sure your child wears the correct footwear.

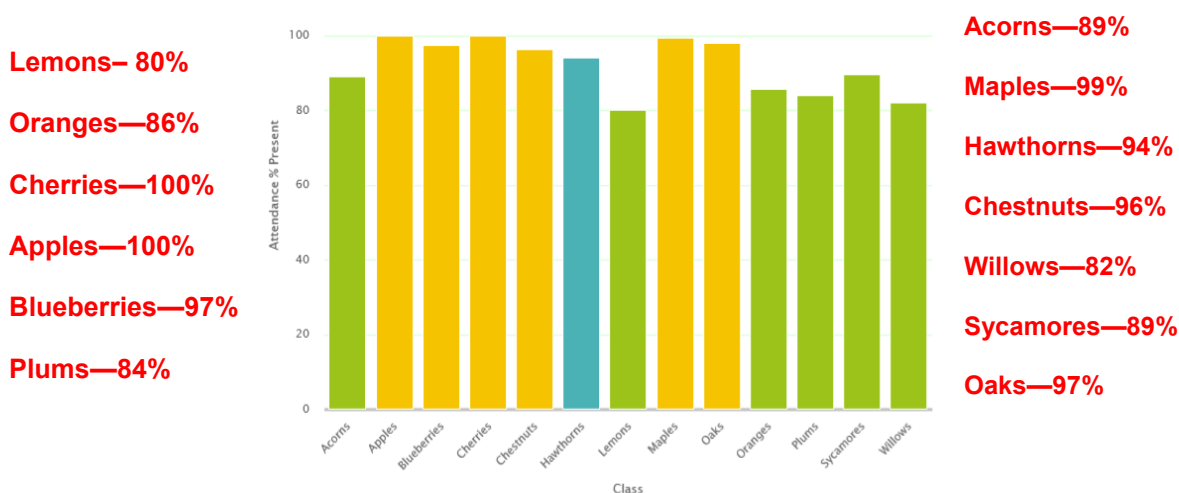
I hope everyone has a restful weekend and I look forward to seeing you all back on Monday.
