I have been so impressed by handwriting in Maples and storywriting in Hawthorns this week! Keep it up!

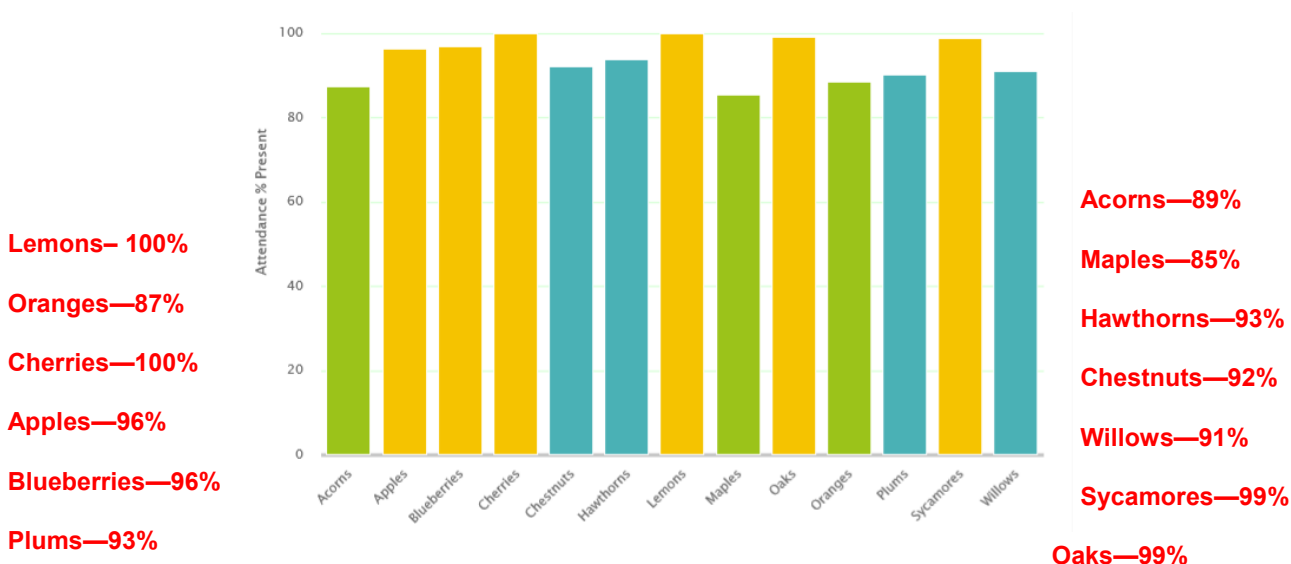
I hope everyone has a restful weekend and I look forward to seeing you all back on Monday.
