Dear Children, Parents, Carers and Governors,

Thank you firstly to all parents and carers for all your help with home schooling. It has been challenging at times for all of us. I would personally like to thank you for keeping things as normal as possible and helping to keep our children learning in such strange times.

We are very much looking forward to your child returning to school on Monday 8th March 2021. We understand that for some children and families there may have been significant changes to your lives. We want to be prepared as possible to support your child on their return to school, particularly in terms of their health and emotional wellbeing. The more information we have prior to their return the better equipped we will be to ensure a smooth transition. Please contact your class teacher through class dojo to share any information. To help us keep everyone safe, please do not send your child to school if they have the following symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A continuous cough
- A loss of taste or smell

If your child displays any of these symptoms, please book a test via NHS 119 and let us know. In addition if your child vomits or has diarrhoea please keep them at home for 48 hours or until they have 48 hours with no symptoms.

- Bubble 2 - Acorns, Maples and Hawthorns: 8.55am – 3.15pm
- Bubble 3 – Chestnuts and Willows: 9.00 am – 3.20 pm
- Bubble 4 - Sycamores and Oaks: 8.50 am - 3.10 pm

Family with siblings will all start at 8.50 am and finish at 3.20 pm to reduce large gatherings on the yard.
