On 12th June it was the anniversary of Anne Franks' birthday. In assembly this week we learnt all about Anne Frank's bravery in wanting to keep her family safe during World War Two by hiding in a building called the Annexe. Anne loved to write and she got a diary for her 13th birthday. She was very pleased with this as she could write down all her thoughts, even though she had to stay really quiet whilst in the Annexe. Other people showed bravery by taking supplies up to the Annexe for the Frank family. Our stars of the week are our pupils who have shown **bravery**, whether it has been through resilience to their work or through bravery in an injury.

As you are aware, on 14th June the Prime Minister announced a 4 week delay to lifting restrictions in England, until 19th July 2021. Whilst this is disappointing, it is understandable given the rise in the more transmissible variant of the virus, and it will allow more time to further accelerate the vaccination programme.
