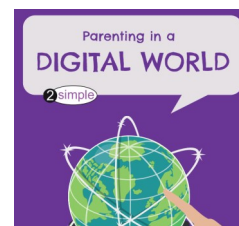
Dear Children, Parents, Carers and Governors,

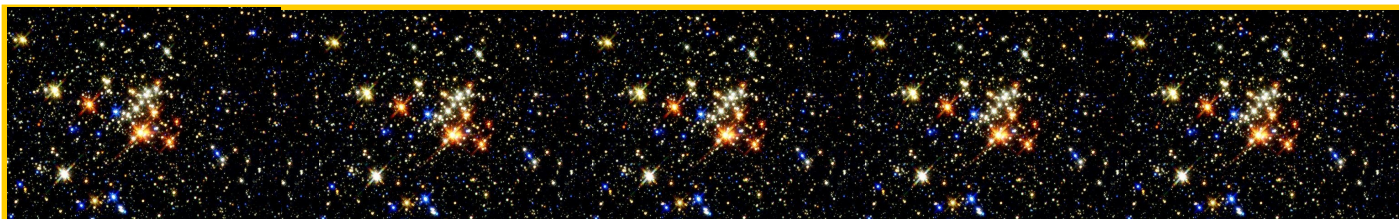
