Dear Children, Parents, Carers and Governors,

This year the National Autistic Society celebrates its 60th anniversary. They have said "We have come a long way and today almost everyone has heard of autism. But far too few people understand what it is like to be autistic. Now it is time to change attitudes. We have therefore decided, based on public feedback, to change World Autism Awareness Week to World Autism Acceptance Week." This week we will be focusing upon what makes us different and how our differences make us unique and special. We always celebrate our individuality at Fellgate. But this week we will think of how we can support people who are different. Our phrase of the week is **Accepting others**.



From today we begin **living with Covid -19**. Adults, young people and children with symptoms of a respiratory infection and who have a high temperature should should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.

Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days. Further advice will be given out to schools today. In the meantime we continue to ensure good hygiene and ventilation.

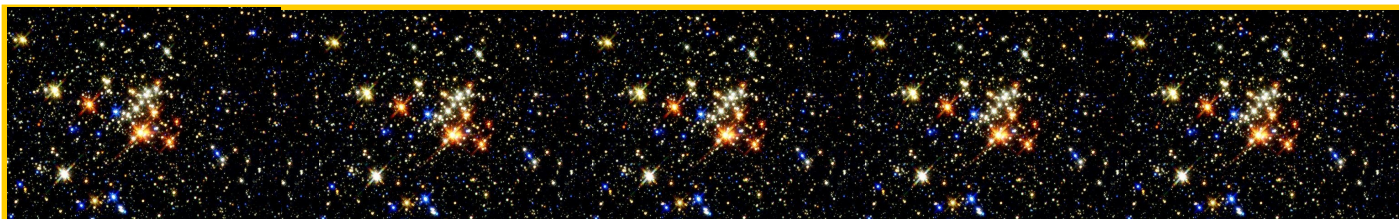
