What is child abuse?



Our reply:  
Child abuse is when a child or young person is being harmed or isn't being looked after properly by a parent, carer or family member.

What should I do?



Our reply:  
Talk to someone, an adult you trust. This could be a neighbour, relative or professional such as a teacher, school nurse, doctor or police officer.

Who could be called to help me?

What happens next?



Our reply:  
The person you speak to will listen to you. Depending on what you say they may need to pass it on to someone who has experience of keeping children safe.

Sometimes we can support you in school or we may ask for support from other people outside of school.
