



Chestnuts: Kevin F for always rising to the challenge in maths.

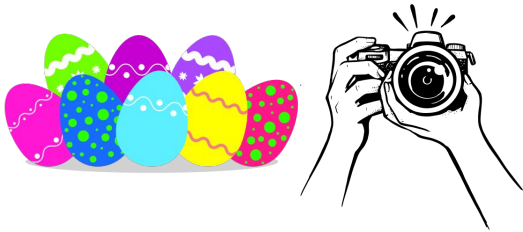
Blossoms: Libby G for her huge enthusiasm in her maths work and for never giving up on tricky activities. Well Done Libby!
