

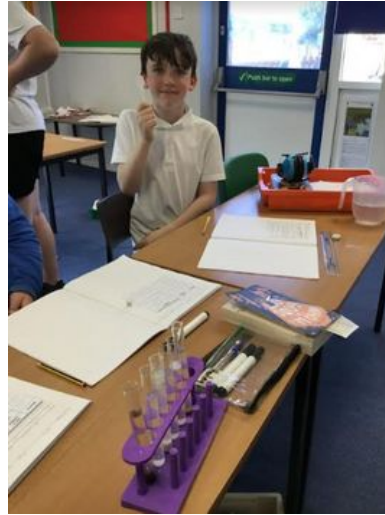
Kate Osborne MP Visit

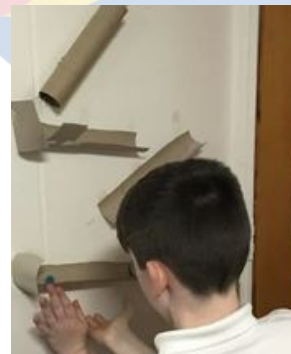
Hollies busy week
