



Phonics / English / Communication

In Rowans class we will learn a lot through play as well as through more structured activities, 1:1s, small groups tasks and Attention Autism tasks.

- I will develop my knowledge of phonics to identify and recall GPCs (grapheme phoneme correspondence).
- I will develop my writing grip to make marks and form letters.
- I will develop my ability to sound and blend words together.
- I will develop my verbal language with all aspects of development including academic learning, personal and social skills.
- I will develop my vocabulary through role play and small world play.
- I will use colourful semantic to help develop my understanding of stories to identify what is happening.
- I will read stories daily in school.
- I will work on SALT targets.

Geography – Different job roles: I will explore jobs that I know, jobs in our school, jobs in our local community, where people work, jobs around the world and identify which jobs I would enjoy.

History - Uniforms past and present: I will learn about what a uniform is, I will learn about linking uniform to jobs, I will compare uniform from the past to now, I will compare police and firefighter uniforms and I will learn why uniforms have changed.

Music – I will learn to sing songs with control and use the voice expressively.

Science – Materials: I will explore and name everyday materials, I will describe materials using my senses, I will explore properties and purposes, I will observe changes to materials, I will learn about reusing and recycling.

PSHE - I will continue to participate in turn taking and sharing activities. I will continue to identify feelings and working on strategies to help regulate. I will learn about good and bad choices.

PE – I will complete a weekly PE session with the PE lead. I will have daily movement breaks. I will complete daily fine / gross motor activities.

RE – I will learn about the Chinese New Year and the story of the Zodiac.

Computing – I will learn to plan a route and input instructions for a floor robot.

Maths – This half term we will be focusing on number recognition, counting, addition and subtraction and nursery rhymes:

- I will be learning to count, recognise, add and subtract numbers to 10 using part whole and bar models.
- I will be learning to represent and will explore the composition of numbers to 10. I will be learning to match, sort and compare.
- I will be learning to talk about measurements and patterns.
- I will be learning to subitise to 6.
- I will learn to identify and name 2d shapes such as circles, triangles and shapes with 4 four sides.

Art – I will explore primary and secondary colours.

DT/Cookery: I will continue to follow simple recipes with guidance. I will prepare and measure ingredients accurately. I will use basic cooking techniques safely.

How to get involved at home: Checking and communicating via Dojo regularly for news and updates. Reading with your child. Reading records will be sent home but they are needed in school on a daily basis. Continuing to develop your child's independent skills e.g. using a knife and fork, put on their coat etc. At meal times and snack encouraging your child to sit.
