

Primary PE and Sport Premium 2017-18

At Christopher Pickering Primary School we believe PE & Sport plays an important role in making our vision statement a reality for every pupil, with the potential to change young people's lives for the better.

We have welcomed the Government's announcement in June 2013 to provide additional funding until 2020 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. We are committed to using this resource in developing high quality PE lessons, alongside greater opportunities for sporting competitions and clubs for all our young people.

Sport Premium Grant

Funding for schools will be calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11). All schools with 17 or more primary aged pupils will receive a lump sum of £16,000 plus a premium of £10 per pupil. Smaller schools will receive £475 per pupil.

What does the Sport Premium mean for our School?

'Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this' (DfE June 2013). At Christopher Pickering Primary School we have split up the funding by the three key areas for consideration; Physical Education, Healthy Active Lifestyles and Competitive Sport. We have decided to spend the Sport Premium Grant on the following:

Sustainability – All children to continue to have a positive attitude towards a healthy, active lifestyle, which contributes towards the positive ethos of sport and physical education in the school.

Impact –

8 children from Foundation Stage are now attending Flex Dance. 7 Y56 children now attend Kingston Athletics as a result of coach Sonia.

Change 4 Life continues to happen 5 days a week. Half-termly sessions show that children are enjoying these sessions, are more confident and feel they know how to lead a healthier life.

Across the school children are starting the day with different activities from Cyber Coach. This is developed into lunchtime dance clubs in Zumba and Street which have been popular with staff.

Overall, more children than ever are taking part in extra-curricular sport at breakfast club, playtime, lunchtimes and afterschool.

100% of our year 6 children can swim 25m therefore no money was needed to be spend this year on extra lessons and support.

Sustainability – Children to enjoy competing in competitive sport and continue to enjoy sport into their adult lives. Any new equipment purchased will have a lifetime longer than the current funding period so will be sustainable.

Impact – Achieved the Sainsbury's School Games Gold Award for the fourth consecutive year- we are now the only school in the City eligible for the Platinum Award which we hope will be awarded at the beginning of the 2018-19 academic year.

Attitudes to healthy lifestyles and competitive sports across the school are key. PE and sport is at the heart of our school, we were chosen as the Yorkshire and Humber school to launch the 'Super movers' campaign.
