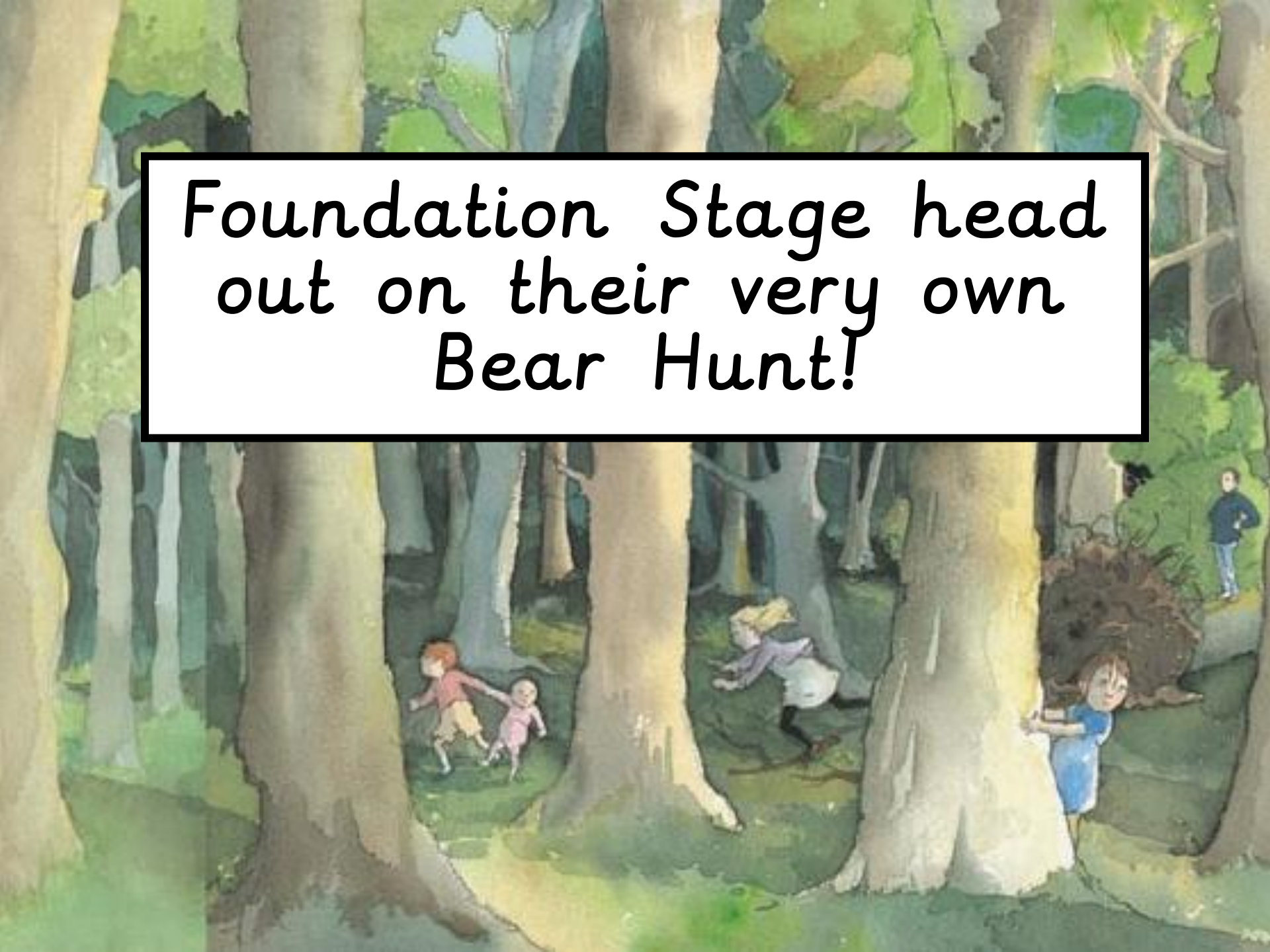

Bear Hunt!



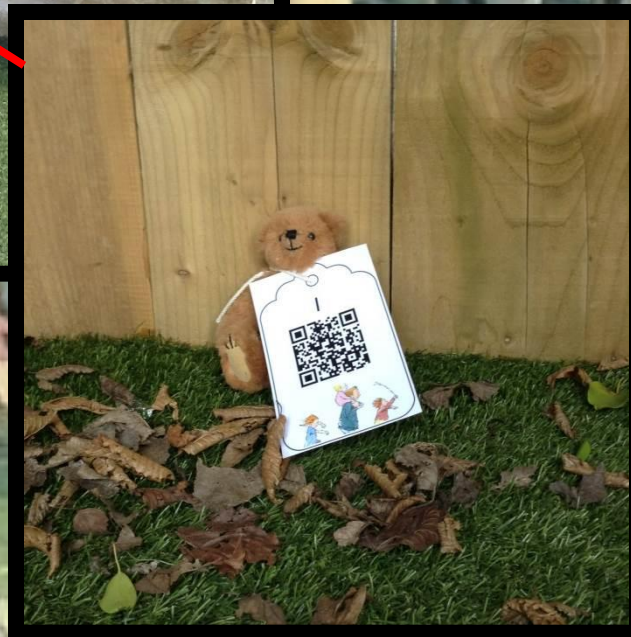


Mrs

Well spotted George, the poly tunnel. Super team work.

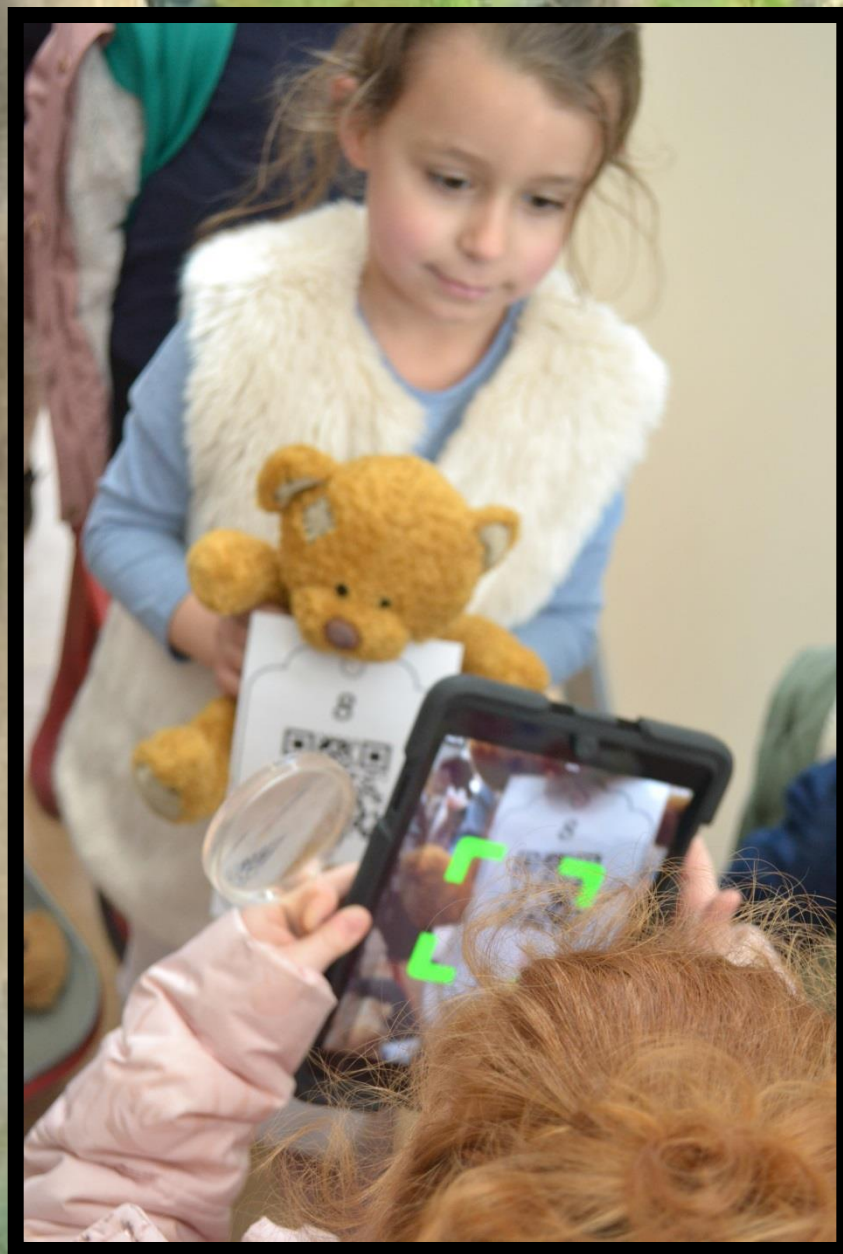


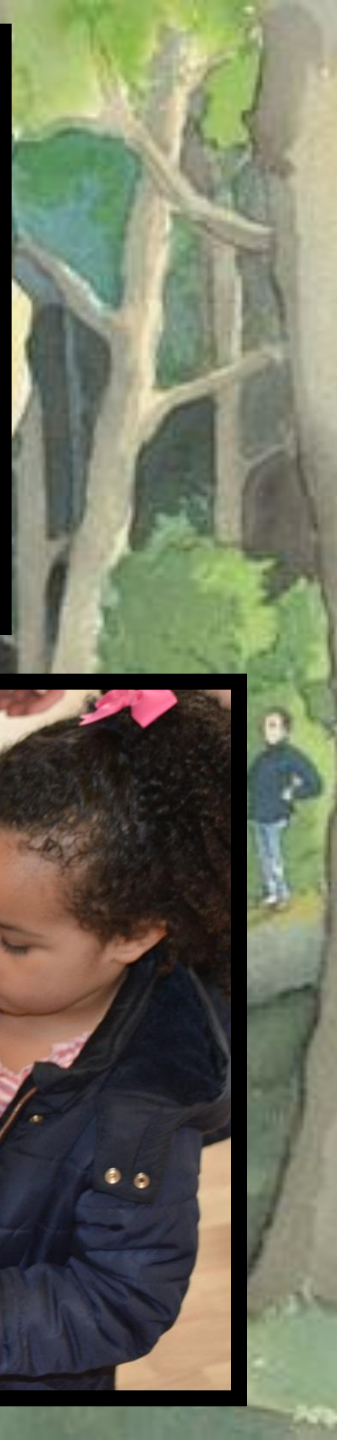
