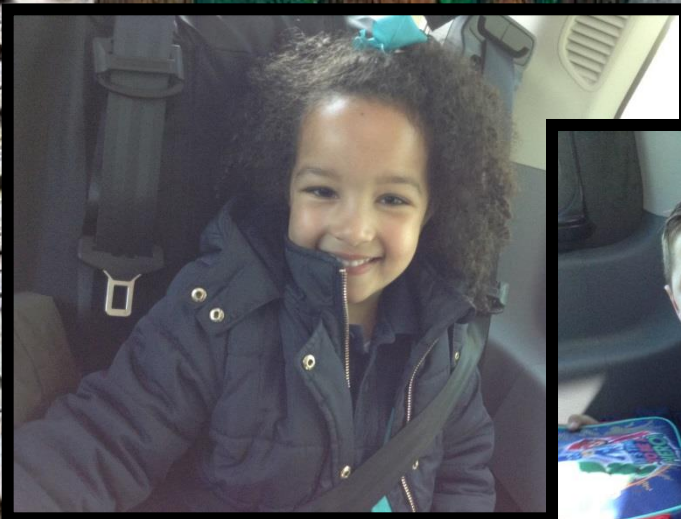

pile house

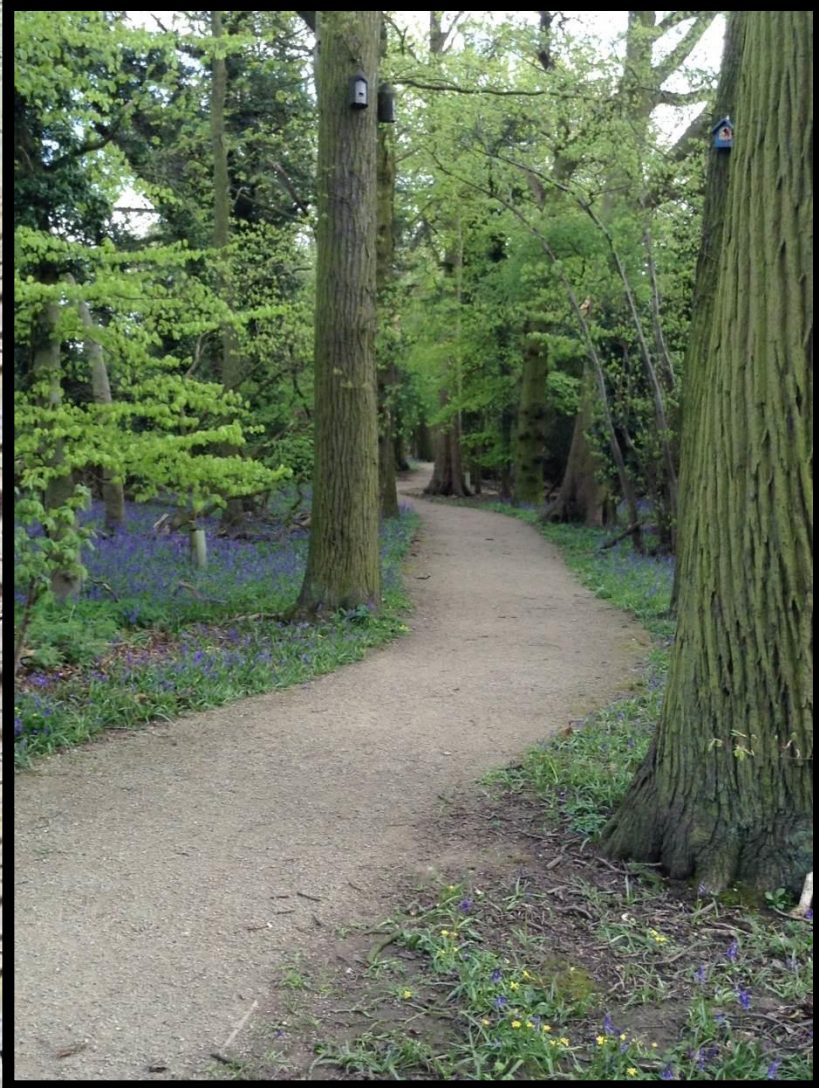


Then we made

the trees.



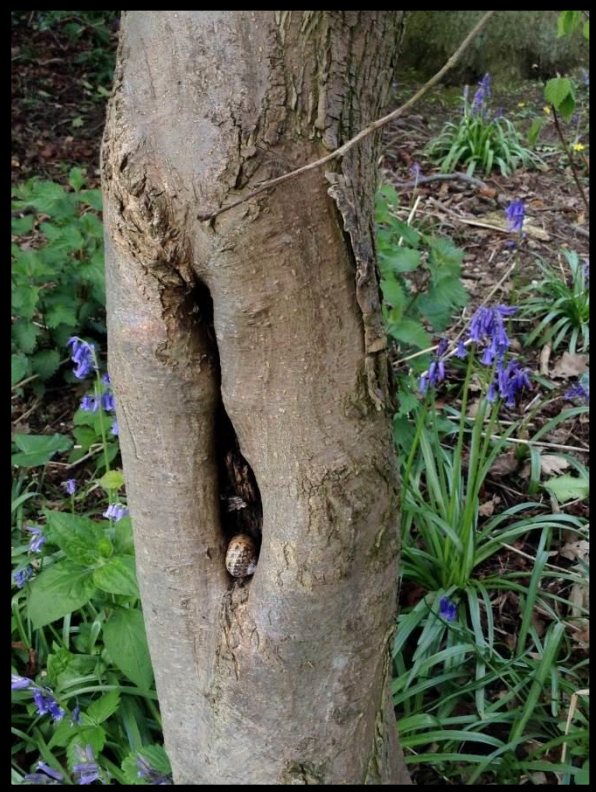


Where will this path lead?

stay there.


Which do you think this is, a Gruffalo hole or a Gruffalo trap? We couldn't quite decide!
