In LITERACY we will be looking at a variety of stories about 'People who help us'. We will be reading the story of 'Miss Dose the Drs Daughter' as she takes over the Dr's surgery! We will also be looking at stories about dentists and the police. In our writing we will be learning to write our names, alongside starting to use our phonic knowledge to write simple words. We will be sequencing stories, making lists and writing labels and captions.

In <u>COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE</u> we will be given opportunities to develop and broaden our vocabulary and talk skills. We will re-tell and re-invent stories using our talk for writing skills.

In <u>PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT</u> we will be working indoors and outdoors. In indoor PE we will focussing on finding a space and making different shapes with our bodies. In outdoor PE we will be working on our gross motor skills, hopping, skipping, catching and throwing! In Dough -Disco and Finger gym we will be concentrating on our fine motor skills.

In EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN we will be exploring self portraits. We will learn how to mix colours together and explore art through a variety of resourceschalk, paint, charcoal.

Using junk modelling materials we will be designing and creating our very own police cars, ambuances and fire engines!

In transient art we will be making houses for the tooth fairy!

In <u>PERSONAL</u>, <u>SOCIAL</u> & <u>EMOTIONAL</u> <u>DEVLOPMENT</u> we will be developing our talk and social skills. We will be taking part in daily circle times, sharing our own ideas and listening to others around us. We will be continuing to look after and respect our classroom, sharing the roles of area monitors and safety inspectors.

In <u>SHAPE</u>, <u>SPACE & MEASURE</u> we will be looking at both 2D shapes-talking about some of their features and properties.

We will be exploring weight, capacity and position through a variety of activities using autumn objects such as conkers and pumpkins.

In <u>UNDERSTANING THE WORLD</u> we will be becoming PEOPLE WHO HELP US! In our STEM Area, we will be ... Police Officers using magnifying glasses looking for clues... refuse collectors sorting rubbish and investigating magnetic and non-magnetic items... doctors and nurses looking at how our bodies work, talking about our bones and keeping healthy... and a dentist thinking about our teeth and how we take care of them. We will be using I-Pads to take pictures of our discoveries along the way!

In NUMBER we will be using Numicon to develop our counting skills. We will be counting objects to 10 and beyond and having a go at recording our numerals.

We will be counting our fingers and toes using rhymes to help us! Then we will be using graphs to record different our eye and hair colour.

Outside will be traffic control officers using tally charts to record how many vehicles pass us.

In **READING** we will be looking at a variety of books and stories about 'People Who Help Us'. We will be using books to develop our language and knowledge. Who helps us when we are ill? How do we keep our teeth healthy? What people work in a hospital? Who we might find there? This term we will also be splitting into Guided Reading groups to develop our talk skills. and shared reading.
