Curriculum Information

Reading

F2 Please ensure that your child brings their reading book into school on their reading day and that it is put into the reading basket. If you are unsure of your child's reading day, please ask.



PE

F2 Children will continue to need their PE kit on a Tuesday. As a reminder, our PE kit is a **white t-shirt, black shorts** plus black or blue jogging bottoms and jumper for outdoor PE on colder days. **Trainers or sandshoes** are also needed. Please note earrings cannot be worn during PE, therefore please remove earrings or we will cover them up with tape.

Snack and baking plea

A reminder that we ask you for a voluntary contribution of 50p a week to enable us to bake and taste a variety of foods with your children. The money box and tick sheets are kept above the children's drawers.



Indoor/Outdoor shoes

To help us keep our school environment looking inviting can you make sure that your child has a pair of sandshoes for indoor use and a pair of outdoor shoes (without laces unless your child can tie them independently), both clearly labelled. Children have the option to access our outdoor area in all weathers so please ensure they have a suitable raincoat on all days.



Lost property

Please ensure all clothing and shoes are clearly marked with your child's name. During the warmer weather, children are more likely to be taking jumpers/ cardigans off therefore items are more likely to be misplaced. Please rest assured we remind children to put their jumpers in their tray but unfortunately it is not always possible to check they have done so. If they are labelled, it makes it so much easier to return to the correct owner.

Sun cream

Please make sure on warmer days sun cream is applied at home in a morning. We suggest you use a product, which once applied, stays effective all day. Children do not need sunglasses (unless for medical reasons) and should not bring them to school. Sun hats however are very welcome - please do not forget to name them.
