Spreading germs

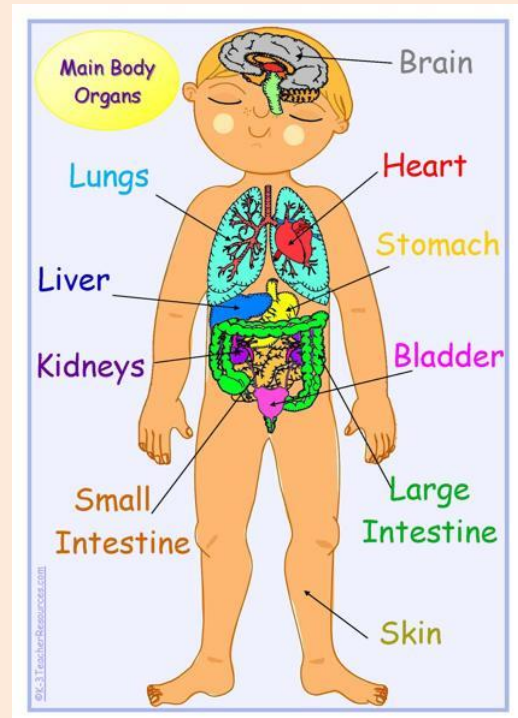


We talked about germs. The doctor painted our hands red and we 'high fived' each other to show how germs spread.
