



The Safer Roads Humber team came to visit us.



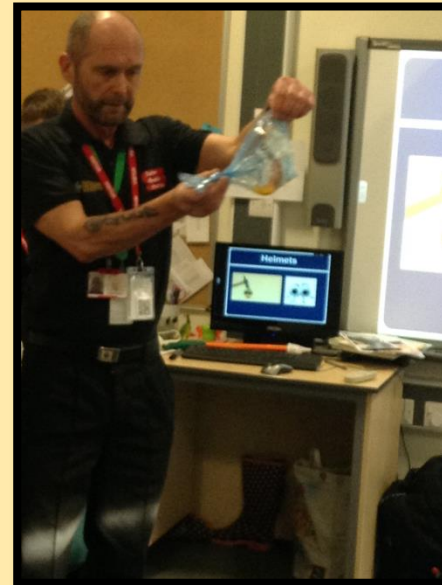
They showed us how important it is to wear a cycle helmet when riding our bike.

Holding hands



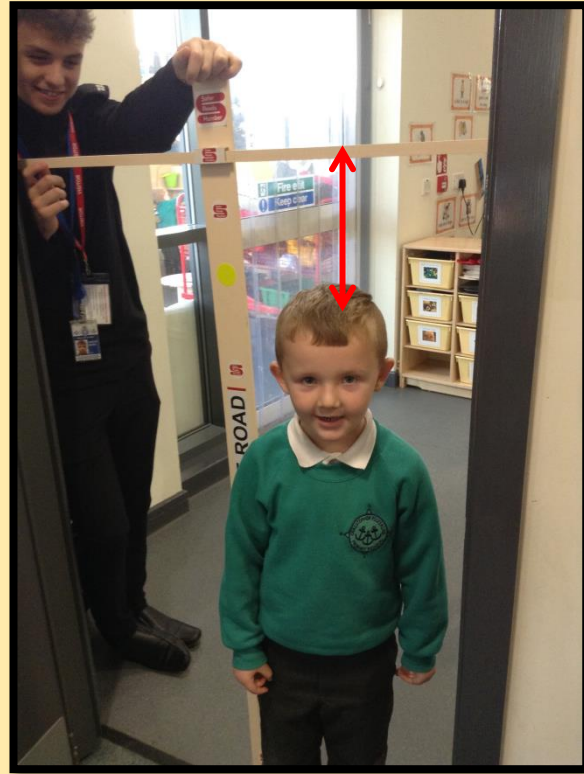
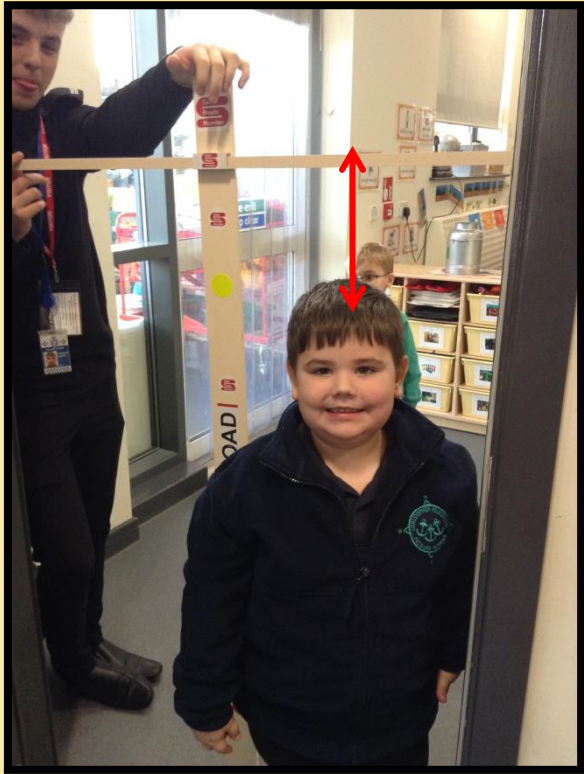
Stop, look and
