


Foundation Stage make

It goes round and round.


Thomas B

Lottie

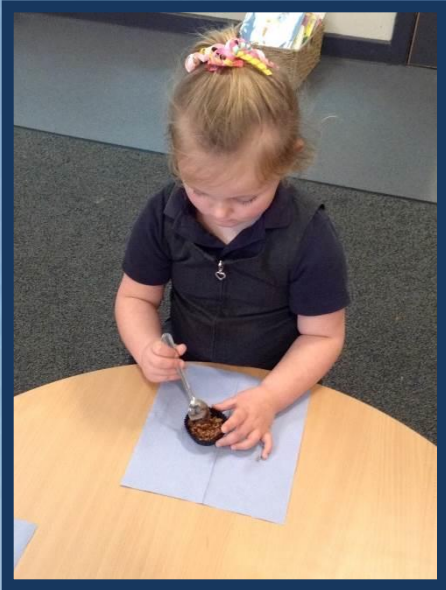
It was time to crack on and get making the buns. The children did a great job and the buns tasted delicious.
