

World Book Day

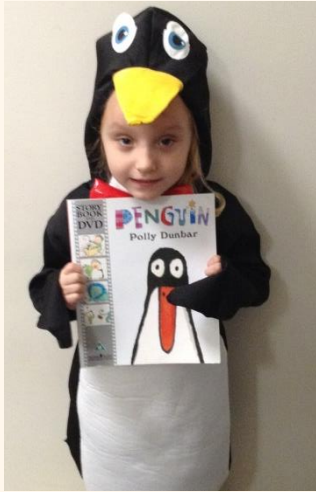

They looked fabulous.



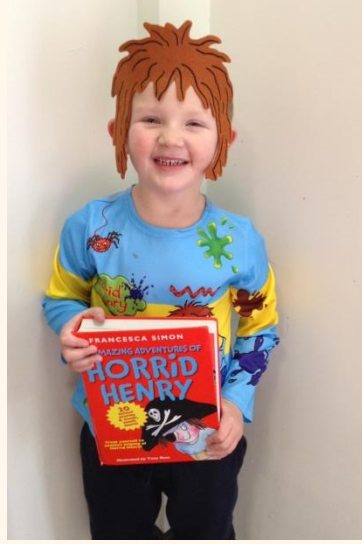
Harvey was 'The Flying Doctor'.

The teachers had their favourite books with them too.

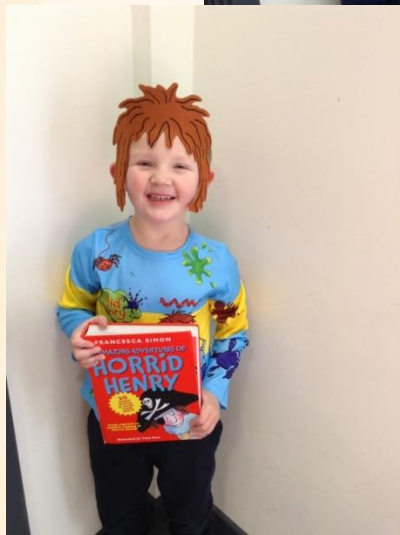

Riding Hoods...

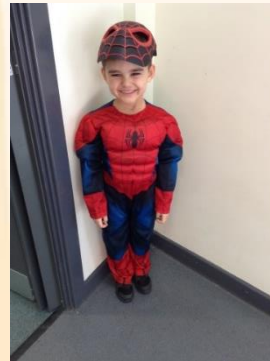


...we had characters

...all sorts of characters.






Later we had special story times, even though it wasn't anywhere near home time!
