

Can you solve these word problems?

You could use pretend objects to help work them out.



At the party, Deacon eats 2 ham sandwiches and 2 cheese sandwiches. How many sandwiches does he have altogether?

Fraya has 6 sausage rolls but then has 1 more. How many does she have altogether?

Betsy has 5 plain buns and 2 chocolate buns. How many does she have altogether?

Harvey has 10 crisps on his plate but his mummy eats 1 of them! How many does he have left?

Thomas has 5 sandwiches but he gives 2 to his dad. How many does he have left?

There are 9 biscuits left on the plate and Charlie eats 3. How many are left?

I'm sure you'll all be really good at working these out. How's about a challenge! Can you write them out as number sentences?
