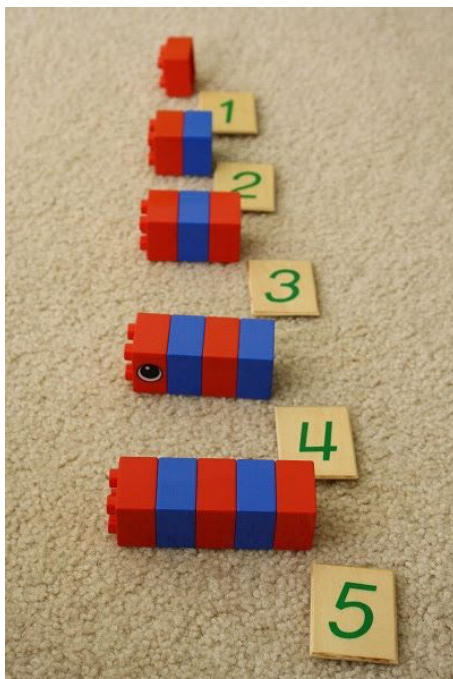


## Maths – Summer Term - Week 4

### Number Recognition and Matching

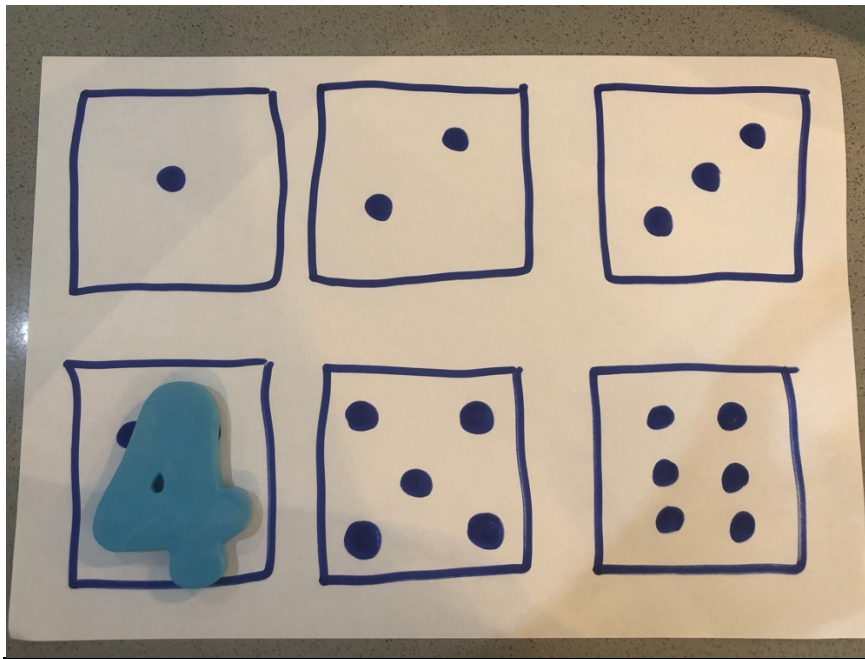
Well done to those of you who managed to try some of the activities for number recognition. This week we are going to progress to number recognition and matching.

#### Lego



Make some labels 1-5. Can your child build a tower the correct size to represent the correct number?

## Treasure hunt



Draw some number representations on a piece of paper. Hide the corresponding numbers around your house. Ask your child to find all of the numbers and put them on the correct number representation. Can they find them all? Maybe there could be a prize at the end?

## Stickers

Count from 1 to 10



Hopefully you might have some stickers at home. Write out numbers on a piece of paper, can your child put the correct amount of stickers next to the correct number?

## Basketball



Find 3 bins or containers. Roll up some paper. Can your child throw the correct amount of paper into the correct basket. Time them to see if they can beat their own time or play against them? If too easy move further back.

## Counting twigs



On your daily exercise, can you find some twigs. Can your child count the correct number of twigs and match them to the correct number?
